

A Level Results - L6th

If you have anything that seems inaccurate on your statements of results please speak to me straight away. You will see that you only have unit results and do not have overall grades. You will not receive these until next summer. However it is possible to work out what AS grades you have got (160=A, 140=B etc.). In many ways your current grade is less important than identifying which units you might wish to improve upon.

Mr Fleming will need to know which subject you are dropping, but you might also wish to consider the following:

- **Resit next year.** You are able to resit individual units in January (most units) and in the summer (all units). You should remember that many boys find it easier to gain extra UMS marks from resiting the AS units than from the A2 units. I will give information to you about resits in the new term, but as a guide you will need to apply and pay for January entries early in October. It might be useful to apply for a copy of the scripts from your exams (by **1st October**). This will also allow you to get advice from your teachers to help you work for your resits.
- You might also wish to apply for a **remark**. Apply by **17th September**. You can apply for a **photocopy of your script** to look at before deciding whether to get a remark. Apply for this by **24th August**. Please remember that marks and grades can go up and down after remarks.

Please use the forms that are in the school hall today and that will be in the letter rack outside the exams office after that. Please follow the instructions on them carefully.
