

A Level Results - U6th

If you have anything that seems inaccurate on your statements of results please speak to me straight away.

Your certificates are sent to us at the beginning of October and are usually available for collection by Skinners' Day. The exam boards advise us not to post these so they should be collected in person. We are also advised to destroy certificates after a year if they are not collected.

If you have not made the grades for your university course, make sure that you have spoken to Mr Fleming. Once you have done this, you might need to do the following:

- **Apply for a priority remark.** This is only for those with university places dependant upon a remark. Make sure that the university knows that you are doing this so that they can hold onto your place. You only have only a short time to apply to me for this (by Tuesday **24th August**) - aim to apply today or Friday.
- **Resit next year.** Several boys do this every year. Deadline for January resits is during October (date tbc) so please contact me at the end of September to discuss this and to arrange payment. You can also resit even if you simply want to improve a grade for other reasons. Summer resits will need to be with me in early March (date tbc). It might be useful to apply for a copy of the scripts from your exams (by **1st October**).
- You might also wish to apply for a non-priority **remark**. This will be returned too late to impact 2010 university entry but might be useful if applying for 2011. Apply **17th September**. You can apply for a **photocopy of your script** to look at before deciding whether to get a remark. Apply by **24th August**. Please remember that marks and grades can go up and down after remarks.

Please use the forms that are in the school hall today and that will be in the letter rack outside the exams office after that. Please follow the instructions on them carefully.
